# Skyline Basketball Tournament Event Protocols

#### Please understand that our primary goals are:

- 1) the safety of our students and community;
- 2) the ability of our students to continue to attend in-person school daily; and
- 3) trying to ensure that our student-athletes have the opportunity to compete and complete their athletic seasons with as few interruptions as possible.
- 4) continuing to be able to allow the parents/grandparents of our student-athletes to be able to come to watch them play

We believe that these guidelines will aid us in achieving these goals.

#### **General Information**

- We ask that you PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND if you are sick or generally not feeling well.
- Concessions will be available at all events with workers wearing face coverings and gloves.
- No gatherings will be permitted on the court at the conclusion of games
- Gametimes have been adjusted to allow more time between games so that fans from one game can leave
  before fans for the next game are admitted. PLEASE UNDERSTAND THAT WHEN YOU PURCHASE
  ADMISSION, YOU ARE PURCHASING ADMISSION FOR ONE SINGLE GAME ONLY, NOT FOR
  MULTIPLE GAMES.

### **Indoor Event Protocols**

### 1. Fans

- a. Fans will enter the facility ONLY ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE BUILDING (NEW GYM LOBBY).
- Gametimes have been adjusted to allow more time between games so that fans from one game
  can leave before fans for the next game are admitted. PLEASE UNDERSTAND THAT WHEN
  YOU PURCHASE ADMISSION, YOU ARE PURCHASING ADMISSION FOR ONE SINGLE
  GAME ONLY, NOT FOR MULTIPLE GAMES.
- c. Face coverings will be required (grade 5 through adults) to gain admission to the event and when in the congested areas such as the lobby/bathrooms or standing in line for concessions. Face coverings may be removed when you are seated to watch the event and socially distanced from other households.
- d. **Home fans/students** will be seated on the south end of the gym (adults/families in chair-back seats; student section in bleachers.)
- e. **Visiting fans/students** will be seated on the north end of the gym (adults/families in chair-back seats; student section in bleachers.)
- f. Social distancing recommended in seating areas (alternate rows will be left empty) & in concession lines
- g. First several rows of bleachers are for team personnel **ONLY**.
- h. You will be asked to leave the facility immediately when your school's game is over, so that we can begin seating for the next game. ALL FANS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THROUGH THE DOORS ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE GYM.(OLD GYM LOBBY) SO THAT YOU WILL NOT CROSS PATHS WITH THE FANS ARRIVING FOR THE NEXT GAME.
- i. PARENTS/GRANDPARENTS: YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY WHEN YOUR TEAM'S GAME HAS CONCLUDED, YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO WAIT AROUND TO SEE YOUR CHILD AFTER THEY FINISH IN THE LOCKER ROOM. WE UNDERSTAND THAT THIS IS

AN INCONVENIENCE, BUT ONCE AGAIN, TWO OF OUR PRIMARY GOALS ARE FOR YOUR KIDS TO GET TO PLAY THESE GAMES AND FOR THEIR PARENTS AND GRANDPARENTS TO GET TO BE HERE TO WATCH THOSE GAMES. IN ORDER TO BE ABLE TO DO THAT, WE NEED TO BE ABLE TO CLEAR THE GYM IMMEDIATELY AT THE END OF EACH GAME.

### 2. Concessions/Hospitality

- a. Concessions will run as usual...
- b. We will NOT have a hospitality room this year. Coaches, bus drivers, and tournament workers will receive a voucher each day for food from the concession stand.

#### 3. Teams

- a. PLEASE DO A TEMPERATURE CHECK ON YOUR PLAYERS BEFORE BOARDING THE BUS. Team buses should park on the east side of the building and TEAMS/CHEERLEADERS SHOULD ENTER ONLY THROUGH THE PASS GATE ON THE EAST SIDE (BACK SIDE) OF THE BUILDING.
  - b. Chairs on team benches placed further apart if possible.
  - c. No cups for water; players bring their own water bottles to use at contests. (We will provide a large cooler filled with ice water.)
  - d. Anyone sitting on team benches who is not currently in the game should have a face covering (coaches, players, managers).
  - e. Players & cheerleaders will only be admitted free to the games in which their schools are playing. Coaches will be admitted free to ALL tournament games.
  - f. Locker rooms will be sanitized at the completion of each game. PLEASE CHECK IN AT THE SCORER'S TABLE TO MAKE SURE YOUR LOCKER ROOM IS READY BEFORE HAVING YOUR TEAM ENTER IT.
  - g. WE WILL NEED YOUR ASSISTANCE IN ENCOURAGING YOUR FANS/PARENTS TO ARRIVE
    JUST BEFORE YOUR SCHEDULED GAME TIME AND GETTING THEM TO DEPART
    IMMEDIATELY WHEN YOUR GAME HAS ENDED. WE ALSO ASK THAT YOUR TEAM AND
    CHEERLEADERS LEAVE IMMEDIATELY AFTER YOUR GAME HAS CONCLUDED. (PLEASE
    HAVE YOUR TEAM BUS ARRIVE NO EARLIER THAN ONE HOUR BEFORE YOUR SCHEDULED
    GAME TIME.)
