LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that on April 4, 2023 the qualified voters of Stoutland R-II School District will elect **three**, 3-year members to the Stoutland R-II School Board of Directors. Persons interested may file at the school district's Business office located at 7584 State Rd T, Stoutland MO 65567.

Filing will begin on December 6, 2022 at 8:00 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. and will continue during the district's regular business hours, which are Monday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Filing will not occur on days that the school district's offices are closed due to inclement weather. Filing will also not occur on the following holidays when the school district's offices are closed: December 22, 2022 and December 26, 2022. Filing will end on December 27, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.

Board members must:

- Be citizens of the United States;
- Be a resident taxpayer of the District;
- Have resided within the District for the one year immediately preceding their election;
- Be at least 24 years of age;
- Not be delinquent in state income, or personal property tax or real property on their residence. If the Board member is a corporate officer of a fee office, that office can't be delinquent on any state tax;
- Not have been guilty of a felony or misdemeanor under federal law, or in another state that would be considered a felony in Missouri;
- Not be a registered sex offender; and
- Be in compliance with all Missouri Ethics Commission requirements.

If elected to the Board you must be willing to file a financial disclosure statement. New Board members must successfully complete eighteen and one-half hours of orientation and training within one (1) year of the date of election or appointment. This training shall include at least two hours and thirty minutes of training that provides up-to-date and reliable information on identifying signs of sexual abuse in children and danger signals of potentially abusive relationships between children and adults, as required by law.

Ballot placement will be determined by the order in which the candidates file, except that for candidates who file a declaration of candidacy prior to 5:00 p.m. on the first day of filing, the District shall determine by random drawing the order in which such candidates' names shall appear on the ballot. Each candidate filing on the first day shall draw a number at random at the time of filing. The District shall record the number drawn with the candidate's declaration of candidacy. The names of candidates filing on the first day of filing shall be listed in ascending order of the numbers so drawn and ahead of the names of candidates filing on a later date.
