## 7-12 Virtual Instruction Procedures

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### Students with Internet Access

- Using links, passwords and PIN numbers provided by your teacher, log into each class period at the schedule start time each day of school, Monday through Thursday.
- Your teacher will provide daily instruction including, but not limited to reviews of material previously presented, introductions of new materials, practice problems, projects, group discussions, assignments and assessments.
- Attendance will be taken each day.
- Absences will accumulate as described in the student parent handbook
- Failure to join the class on time may result in a tardy.
- Behavior referrals and disciplinary consequences shall be issued for inappropriate conduct as determined by the instructor and as described in the student parent handbook.
- Teachers will indicate which assignments and assessments will be graded
- All grades issued during virtual instruction shall be part of the student's final semester grade
- Attendance and grades shall also be included in determining student eligibility for participation in extracurricular activities as described in the athletic handbook and in accordance with the MSHAA guidelines
- Attendance and grades shall also be included in determining a student's final A+ status
- Teachers shall be available by phone, email, and virtual meeting, Monday through Thursday, 12:30 to 4:00 p.m., by appointment for individual or small group assistance.
- Teachers will provide students with instructions and procedures to schedule appointments as needed
- All applicable policies, rules, and procedures in Adopted Board Policy and the Board approved Student Parent Handbook will be enforced.

### Students without Internet Access

- Students with daily access to a cell phone or home phone (*long distance charges may apply*) may be
  provided with a local Stoutland phone number to call in and join each period of instruction though audio
  only. Please call or email your teacher to see if this is an option. This option will be provided at the
  discretion of each individual teacher. Individual teachers will determine if their content can be effectively
  delivered via an audio only option.
- Each day beginning the Tuesday, October 13, the morning bus will drop off USB flash drives as needed and determined by the individual teacher, for each class.
- USB flash drives, as may be appropriate for each of the student's class periods, may contain, but not
  limited to, a recording of the prior days virtual instruction including assignments, assessments or other work
  required of the student.
- Beginning Wednesday, October 14, as instructed by the teacher, students shall return to the morning bus driver, all USB flash drives requested by each teacher.
- Students are responsible for meeting the bus at the scheduled time the bus makes its usual stop.

- Failure to meet the bus each morning to pick up and/or return USB Flash Drives may result in an absence assigned for each class that day.
- Your teacher will provide daily instruction including, but not limited to reviews of material previously presented, introductions of new materials, practice problems, projects, group discussions, assignments and assessments.
- Attendance will be taken each day.
- Attendance will be based upon daily audio participation or pickup and/or return of USB flash drives each morning bus stop or return of the of USB flash drives as required and communicated by each individual teacher.

- All applicable polices, rules, and procedures in Adopted Board Policy and the Board approved Student Parent Handbook will be enforced.

# Morning bus stops for delivery of meals, USB flash drives and pick up of USB flash drives

- Students/parents who desire that meals be delivered shall call or email the Director of Food Service and request delivery no later than Monday, October 12, 8:00 a.m.
- Food Service Director, Tara Brown by email <u>tarabrown@stoutlandschools.com</u> or by phone call (417/286-3711 Ext 906); please leave a message when you call.
- Your email or call requesting meal delivery must include student(s) full name, grade level and complete address.
- Upon request for meals as outline above, beginning Tuesday, October 13, morning bus drivers will deliver 7-12 students three meals including breakfast, lunch and an afternoon super snack.
- Morning routes will run their same routes with each stop occurring at approximately the same time it arrived prior to the beginning for the current 7-12 virtual instruction session.
- Students should expect some variance in the time of arrival on the first morning due to the increased number of stops for students who previously drove to school each morning.
- After the first morning, Monday, October 12, buses should arrive at approximately the same time each day with a variance of plus or minus 10 minutes for unanticipated delays in distributing food and instructional materials each morning.
- Students are responsible for meeting the bus each morning at the designated time to receive meals and USB Flash drives.
- Bus drivers will not make return trips to deliver meals, USB flash drives or pick up USB flash drives, should the student fail to meet the bus each morning.
