Safety Improvements



Stoutland R-II Awarded \$84,000 Grant to Improve Building Security.

Stoutland R-II was awarded \$84,055.00 in federal funds over a two-year period under the 2019 COPS Office School Violence Prevention Program (SVPP). The local cash match required for this award is \$28,018.00. Four security improvements are complete or nearly complete as a result of this grant. Installed and operational last fall was the addition of an IP phone system that provides direct internal dialing and communications from all school locations including our bus barn, athletic facilities and all classrooms. The most visible project is security enhancements to the main entrance of the building with the construction of a vestibule to provide a more customer friendly entrance including an in person greeting while limiting access to the rest of the school. As part of the vestibule project, keyless entry has been added to all exterior doors providing centralized control and automation of all exterior doors. The third project was the addition and upgrades to security cameras throughout the building and along all exterior walls that will provide 24/7 monitoring of all movement including enhanced imaging to more readily identify potential problems and provide a better deterrent of unwanted behavior. These enhancements are scheduled to be completed and fully operational prior to the Thanksgiving break.

Elementary Student Council

Sixth graders learned about elections and were given the option to run for Student Council. Student Council is something new for the elementary this year, and will be sponsored by Mrs. Moore and Ms. Williams. Only 6th graders were allowed to run, but 3rd through 6th grade voted on the candidates. Those who did not choose to run worked on committees for the candidates. Each candidate had to write and present a speech, and create posters and campaign buttons. Eight students were elected to the council. So far student council has helped coordinate Grandparents' Day, fall decorations, and Red Ribbon Week.
