

Plans to Begin Roof Repair

At the September 2022 monthly meeting of the Stoutland R-II Board of Education, the Board unanimously voted to begin a long-term repair and maintenance roofing project of District facilities. This 1.8-million-dollar project will be implemented immediately. Over half of this project is being funded using federal grant monies, include ESSER III. The additional funding will be a small amount coming from the hefty reserves the District has built within the last three years. **This investment in the District will be completed without an increase in the taxes of patrons, without requesting the passing of a bond issue and without borrowing money for completion with a lease purchase.** The Board of Education and District administration have been diligently working, planning and saving for this "rainy day."

In the last three years, the District has purchased new math, science, social studies, fine arts and practical arts curriculum for students in grades kindergarten through twelfth grade. Most recently, a new preschool curriculum has been purchased and implemented in the Tiger Cub Child Development Center. Language Arts curriculum will be reviewed and updated in 2023. The District has purchased and implemented enrichment programs in both math and literacy. The District is utilizing assessment programs to assess student achievement and the collection of data from those assessments is used to assist teachers in planning and the education of students. All the while, the District was able to give raises to faculty and staff in order to attract and retain quality individuals to be a part of the success of Stoutland students. The educational success of the students of Stoutland R-II is the number one priority for the District and Stoutland R-II is investing in that success.
